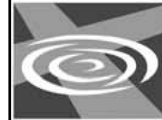

a fun environment during the sessions"

The funding for the drama has come from the Highbury Partnership and the group has a final trip to see Ghost Bay at the Door at the Rep Theatre in Birmingham.
