## Tree of Hope

On Saturday 24th November we gathered in All Saints Church for a time of reflection on bereavement. Anchored in the Christian tradition, a simple ceremony made space for people of any faith or none to reflect on loss and hope. Then in the Village Square we switched on the Christmas lights on a Tree of Hope. Prompted by the death of Hope Fennell a year ago in a traffic accident on our High Street, we offer this tree as an opportunity for anyone who has been bereaved to remember the person they have lost.

During the next three weeks, you can tie a ribbon on the rope around the tree: to remember those who have died, to admit our sadness, to brighten our hope for the future. If you would like the person's name to be remembered in Church over the Christmas period, give their name in at the All Saints Centre Welcome Desk. This year, in Hope's memory, the Fennell family encourage donations to the Road Safety charity Road Peace.

"We were impressed by the level of finish and quality. It looked like it would stand good use over a number of years. It's good to see something like this being done so well in what are remarkably tough times."

As part of ASCDC's whole Campus redevelopment plan, the Village Square design was conceived and executed by Simon Watkins, RGA Landscape Designer, who worked closely with the ASCDC Steering Group and All Saints Community Arts, to realise a scheme which included significant Artwork inspired by local community groups, facilitated by Community Artist Alison Ogle. The main funders were Big Lottery Community Spaces and Birmingham City Council; initial set-up funding came from Kings Heath BID. The Square was opened on 15th October 2011 by The Bishop of Birmingham and the Lord Mayor, and celebrated its First Anniversary last month. The project was also an award Finalist in the category 'Partnership Working'.
