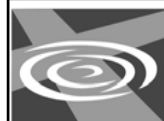

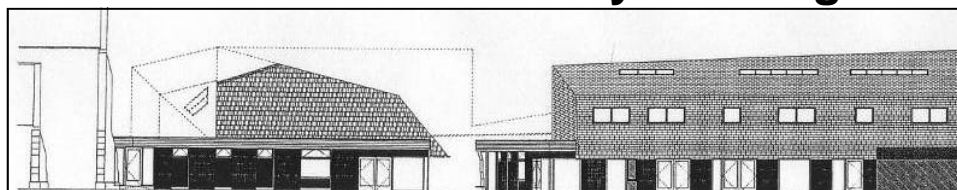

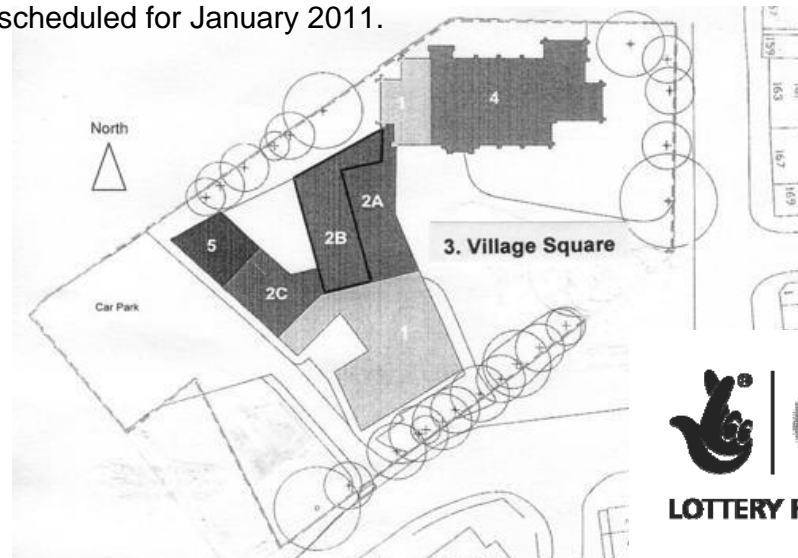
## Work starts on the next phase of All Saints Community Building
