The Village Square – not long to go now!

A view across the square from the High Street shows the completed path that runs from the War memorial entrance to Vicarage Road. The down lighting is in place and granite blocks for the labyrinth have arrived and are being installed as the focal point at the centre of the square. Funded by Community Spaces, Birmingham City Council and Kings Heath Centre Partnership, the new square will be officially opened in the presence of The Lord Mayor, Councillor Anita Ward and The Rt. Revd. David Urquhart, Bishop of Birmingham at 10am on Saturday 15th October 2011. Afterwards there will be an opportunity to join in a "Big Draw", where people can draw their impressions of the Village Square and these will form the basis of an exhibition in All Saints Centre. The day will be rounded off by a lively Family Barn Dance.

Please do come along and join in the celebrations to mark the opening of the first new public square in a suburban shopping centre in Birmingham for at least 40 years.
