Extended Services Groups for Older People

The Robin Centre has been working on developing other groups aside from the day centre to offer older people supportive environments to meet and socialise.

The Health Living Group Wed 1.10pm-2.10pm will recommence on 5th September in the main hall. This is a group where everyone is welcome and includes an activity & light refreshment. No personal care can be undertaken by staff. The charge is £1.50 for this group.

A New Friday group will commence from late September and will be held in the hall. The time this will run will be 12noon-2.30pm. A light lunch will be provided and the session will include activities and socialisation. This will be run by care staff, with support from volunteers, however they will not be able to assist with personal care. The cost for this session will be £6.50.
