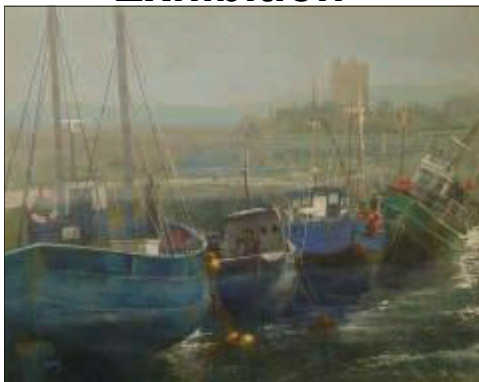

Royal Award for Brian

Congratulations to Brian Miles who has received an MBE in the new years honours list for services to young people. Brian has been involved in voluntary youth work since he was 17 when he helped run a youth club at Christ Church Yardley Wood, After a break of 4 years for university he, with a small team of volunteers, converted a room in the church hall into a coffee bar and opened a twice weekly youth club for local young people.

This Coffee Bar Club continued when the new youth and community centre was opened in the early 70's. After marrying and moving to Moseley Brian then became a volunteer for BAYC, taking craft work around youth clubs and also becoming a field officer supporting those working with young people.

In 1987 Brian, with his wife Mary, decided to reopen the Thursday youth club at All Saints, which they were now attending. All Saints has a long history of youth work with local young people and Brian and Mary were happy to become part of this tradition. After 10 years Brian felt that All Saints could offer more to young people so the All Saints Youth project was opened and has grown and developed since then.

Heavily involved in the community development on the All Saints site Brian always kept in his mind the importance of the young peoples centre despite the problems in finding funds to support it. When BCC offered some money to build



the shell of this Brian led the team who have done all the decorating and internal fitting out of this space with young people from both South Birmingham College and our own youth project being involved. As a member of the youth management committee and its leading fundraiser and over many years, Brian, through his commitment has made a difference to the lives of many young people.

When asked how he felt about the award an embarrassed Brian said "this is not just an award for me but also a recognition of all the people who have helped and supported the work that has been done both in the early days at Christ Church but also at All Saints with our amazing youth project and hopefully will continue to raise the profile of the importance of supporting young people" Brian will be receiving his award at Buckingham Palace on March 21st.
