Election Question Time

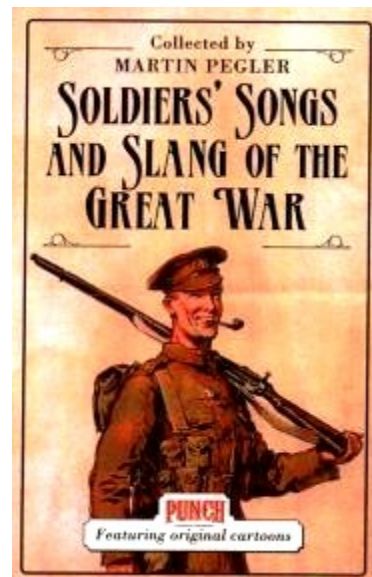
