Inclusion+ group) went away to

had been away as a group friends  
and no parents. They were  
accompanied by five staff from All  
Saints Youth Project. Everybody  
thoroughly enjoyed it and are now  
arranging fundraising event so  
they can go again next year.

We wish to extend our opportunities  
for people with learning disabilities and  
behaviour issues who are aged 19 plus.  
This part of our project is called Inclusion+

in the delivery of activities for adults with  
learning disabilities and behaviour issues  
aged 19 years upwards. Currently these  
activities are: Skills based training  
programme – Wed 3pm – 5pm Social  
activities (on and off site) – Wed 5.30pm –  
8pm. The worker will be part of a multi-  
disciplinary team and there may be  
opportunities for further development of  
this project in the future. Hours: 6 hrs per  
week. Pay: £8.25 per hr. Interviews will be

2nd November. You will also need to  
attend a session with young people on  
Tues 25th or Thurs 26th Oct. for 1 hr.
