Hello friends!

My name is Emily, I'm your Children
and Families Minister at All Saints,
hopefully for the next three years. I can't
believe how time's flown and it's
December already! Let me introduce
myself and give you a snapshot of what's
happening here at the moment.

Before being headhunted by
Birmingham Diocese, I've worked with
children's and families ministry around the
UK, been a missionary in South Africa and
Peru, and most recently I was Youth and
Children's Minister at Beverley Minster in
East Yorkshire which I loved, and I'm
really excited to see what God has
planned for Kings Heath! Lisa and I arrived
in September with a study full of
resources, a head full of ideas and a
passion to serve the families in this area!
We've moved into a lovely house beside
Swanshurst Park, complete with a cat and
three axolotls (basically underwater
dragons!!).

The first few weeks have been spent
drinking lots of coffee, getting to know
people, places and projects ongoing here
to get a feel for where God might best use
my time and gifts. Schools have been
receptive in having me in for assemblies
and Christmas Fayres, the Food and Craft
Markets on the village square have kindly
allowed me to run children's craft activities
and do face-painting at their monthly
events, and I've come alongside young
families at the Stay & Play group based in
the All Saints Centre. I've met a lot of
brilliant people, and had the privilege of
planning and leading the last two All-age
Services with talented local families (watch
out, I may nab you for the next ones!).

There are different challenges and
opportunities here than I've been used to
previously, and in particular I'm developing
an interfaith parenting course for young
families wanting to explore spirituality in a
diverse culture – watch this space!! I'm
blessed to have great colleagues and an
invaluable resource like the Cafe to draw
on as a space to host children's activities.



We've already had an informal 'Light
Party' before Halloween, and you'll often
find me in there with a pile of board
games, crafts and conversation for Cafe-
users and passersby. I'm aiming to turn
this into a regular weekly time-slot for
primary school-aged children to attend
regularly.

At the time of writing I'm preparing for
our first Family Day based on Julia
Donaldson's book 'Stick Man'. It looks set
to be a lovely day with storytelling, crafts,
refreshments, games, prayer activities,
helping to decorate the knitted tree and
much more... These Family Days are
scheduled every couple of months, the
next is planned for January 28th, and any
support you can offer beforehand or on the
day would be wonderful, please.

Do come and ask me anytime about
ideas and hopes for All Saints. There are
exciting times ahead! Please pray for all
those involved in ministry with children,
young people and families, and keep an
