## All Saints Youth Project

Activities on the Village Square have been up and running since November 2016, where we engage with young people outside of the traditional youth club sessions. The Village Square is a place where young people like to congregate after school has finished, and the idea of having provision there is to engage young people on their terms, and reach out to those that may not want to access the youth project in other ways.

Some of the key aims for the provision on the Village Square are: To provide a safe environment for young people, where they feel welcome, and free to express themselves without fear of harassment.

To engage in positive activities in order to develop skills, talk to new people and make new friends, and to have a youth worker to talk to if they need any support or advice.

Over the past few weeks, the Youth Project has been working on ideas to revamp the provision for the village square. This has included a "challenge day" on Wednesdays where young people have the opportunity to take part in various challenges with the chance of winning an edible prize. We are looking at ways to reach a wider number of young people, and create the opportunity to do some project work with young people. We have also ordered some new swing-ball sets to replace the old and broken ones.

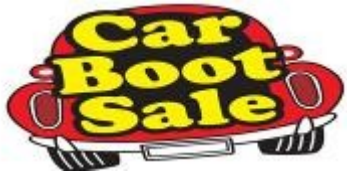

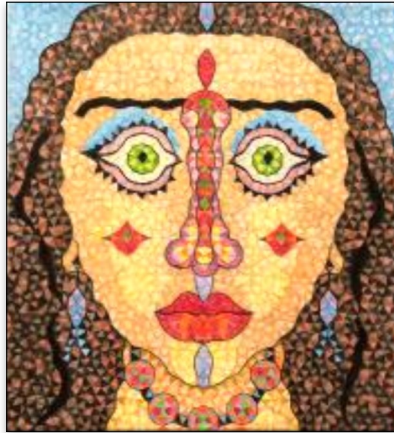

**ABOUT FACE mask drawings  
by Janice Rider  
28th May - 22nd July 2018**



The current craze for colour therapy books was brought to Janice Rider's notice by a gift of the Penrose Tiling pattern book, created by mathematician Sir Roger Penrose. Attracted to these blank patterns, closely reminiscent of the geometrics of Islamic Art, she set herself the challenge of evoking 'Faces' from within the differently patterned pages. The resulting images surprised her: faces appeared, displaying elements of performance masks from bygone civilizations, referencing tribal and totemic patterns and reflecting Janice's ongoing interest in cultural difference and similarity. Each portrait is unique and hand coloured using Ink Intense and water soluble pencils.

**Who are we?**

All Saints Youth Project has been providing recreational and informal educational opportunities for young people aged 11 to 19 years old (up to 25 for those with disabilities) since 1998. We have a strong commitment to developing an inclusive project open to all young people, regardless of ability or background, to support their transition from adolescence to adulthood. The Parent Project was created to enable us to deliver a more integrated approach by addressing the needs of the family.

We have a vacant post for a worker in Inclusion+, our developing provision for young adults (19 plus) with learning disabilities and additional needs.

We provide 2 sessions on a Wednesday afternoon and evening for skills based and independent living support and social activities. The afternoon session takes place in our young people's centre and the evening session is out in the community. We also provide opportunities for work experience and an annual residential
