## Kings Heath Village Square update



Construction of the Village Square is now well underway as this photograph taken from the first floor window of All Saints Centre shows. Some grave stones have been temporarily moved to allow ground work to be carried out. They will then be returned to their original position. Removal of trees that are in poor condition and others that are not part of the scheme has taken place and these will be replaced by over 20 new trees. Some of the timber from felled trees will be used by local craftsmen and for a sensory play garden for disabled children.



As shown left, construction of a new path to the east of the church is underway and the new location for the war memorial is being prepared.

The main funders for the village square construction are the Big Lottery Community Spaces Programme administered by Groundwork, Birmingham City Council and Kings Heath Centre Partnership.

## NEWS FROM ALL SAINTS YOUTH PROJECT

At last the project has had a bit of good news with regard to fundraising. Funding has been secured from Children In Need for £69,000 over three years. This will help us fund our Young Leaders in the Community worker who supports young people who volunteer on our site and in the community, those working on Youth Achievement Awards (the picture shows a recent award presentation event) and young people moving from primary to secondary school. Whilst this doesn't mean that the project can continue with the same level of provision as previously at least we know that there will be

some level of provision and as you can imagine this has come as a huge relief.

Congratulations and thank you to all those who have worked so long and hard to put the bid together. There is still a need to secure a substantial amount of funding for the other areas of the project, in particular our Gateway to Inclusion group and Parent Project.
