Welcome to 'Outlook' your free news letter keeping you up to date on progress from the All Saints Community Development Company.

We plan to bring you the latest information on a regular basis.

Are you wondering what happened to the gates from the front of All Saints Church?

Well as part of our plans for the future they had to be moved for the New Village square. They date back to the 1920's when the church had railings (which were taken down during the Second World War for their material to help with the war effort.) Over the years they have had many coats of paint but no other attention to

them. We now plan to fully refurbish them and re- erect them at the entrance to the memorial garden which is behind the Church at the road end of the north passage. They will be repainted black and will form an ideal entrance to this quiet area. By removing them to a more suitable place we can create the new village square which is being planned with Birmingham City Council planners to provide a wonderful community heart to Kings Heath.

The New 'Welcome Space'

Construction started in October of the first stage of the new community building at All Saints. Comprising a welcome and meeting space, plus kitchens and toilets the new facilities will be available in June 2009. They will be used during the week for an Older Persons Resource Centre and available at weekends for other uses (e.g. exhibitions)

The Village Square

Birmingham City Council has earmarked £200,000 towards the cost of a new village square in Kings Heath. Located at the corner of the High Street and Vicarage Road, work should start in the 2009-10 financial year. It is proposed that a joint working party including council officers and representatives from Kings Heath Centre Partnership and All Saints oversee the proposals.
