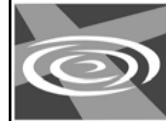

## Village Square Work Starts Soon

Following many years of planning and fundraising, a start will be made in January on the construction of Kings Heath Village Square. Located at the junction of High Street and Vicarage Road the square will occupy the area bounded by All Saints Church, All Saints Centre and the public highway.

After the erection of perimeter fencing, work will start initially in the churchyard with each gravestone and surrounding land being surveyed and the condition, level, orientation and position of the stone recorded. Each gravestone will be temporarily removed so that the area around each stone can be made good. Each stone will then be returned to its original location.

An early activity will be the relocation of the war memorial (pictured) to a new position at the east end of the church where it will be more visible with space around it for ceremonial activities. The memorial is built in sand stone,

stands approximately 3.10 metres high and is generally in very good condition. In its new location the memorial will be surrounded by seating to allow for rest and quiet reflection and the memorial will have the eastern church façade as its backdrop.

The main funders for the construction contract are the BIG Lottery and Birmingham City Council. Kings Heath Centre Partnership helped fund the initial design work and public consultation.
