Location for stage two of the community building which is supported by a £475,000 Big Lottery grant


An aerial view from the North West showing the various stages of our development project

On 24th March over 100 people gathered to celebrate the launch of the 10 year anniversary celebrations of All Saints Youth Project. Compared by Jo Burrows (Youth Project Development Manager) there was a balloon launch of 30 purple balloons which blew dramatically over Award certificate by Les Hemus of the church roof, a toast with fizzy (non-alcoholic) wine and the cutting and eating of a celebration cake.

The chair of the youth management committee - Mary Miles, outlined the history of the Project and praised its success. She reminded people that, as a voluntary
