Youth Project

All Saints Youth project had been delivering a highly successful holiday scheme for young people over the last 10 years. This scheme has run during the school holidays, except for Easter, and has offered places to 20 targeted young people to take part in a range of activities and funded through the Positive Activities for Young People programme (PAYP). The young people who attended PAYP were those at risk of becoming involved in crime or having problems at school. They were some of our most vulnerable young people. Alongside this scheme and with extra funding, we have been able to involve 20 young people with special needs. This has made the holiday work an inclusive project and an innovative piece of work valued by the young people and parents. We had a contact to deliver PAYP through until February 2011 but we have now heard that our October scheme will be our last.

'My son loved coming to the holiday scheme, it meant he could mix with other mainstream young people and not stay stuck in the house' (parent of young person with extra needs). 'I am very unhappy that the scheme has finished. My daughter was having real problems at school through bullying and finds it very difficult to make friends - the holiday scheme built her confidence and she looked forward to it everyday' (parent of 14 year old girl). Mary Miles, chair of the youth management committee said 'we feel that our holiday work is an important part of our project. We will work hard to find some funding to run some holiday work but times are tough and fundraising is a major task for the whole of our project. If anyone has any suggestions of how to raise this money we would be pleased to hear them and if anyone would like to join our regular giving scheme please get in touch'.
