

# **Hope Fennell**

Saturday 15th September would have been Hope Fennell's fourteenth birthday, had she not been run over by a lorry on Kings Heath High Street last year. Such immeasurable loss provoked much sympathy and concern in Kings Heath for her family who, in turn, suggest that we channel those energies of concern into making our neighbourhood safer. Several hundred people walked along the High Street with drums and flags that day, gathering in Village Square to hear encouragement to be vigilant about road safety. Suggestions of practical improvements were made by Councillor Lisa Trickett. Mrs Fennell spoke of her hope that no other family experience such loss. A rock band played. A prayer was offered. Cyclists and parents and children talked about the issues. Balloons floated up. Road Peace encouraged the signing of a petition. Out of the tragedy something grew that was, you might say, positively sad.
