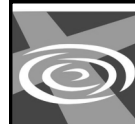

Go Green Week 15th – 21st June

On Sat 21st June, 30 stall-holders, a dozen musicians, the village square café, and 100's of Kings Heath residents joined together for a great day of celebrating, sampling, reflecting and acting on numerous ideas for how we might shrink our carbon footprint. It was a great day, and a marvellous illustration of how going Green can be creative, empowering and fun.

This was the culmination of a week of reflection on all things Green, enjoyed by All Saints. The week began on Sunday 15th June, when Canon John Wilkinson returned to the church to deliver an inspiring sermon, where he spoke of the absurdity of the pursuit of limitless growth when our resources are limited, and how we need to turn around from this way of thinking. The service was followed by an excellent speaker, Mark Letcher from Operation Noah who spoke of the urgency of halting any further search for new fossil fuel reserves, and of turning to carbon-free sources of energy generation in order to stop global temperatures rising to dangerous levels.

He spoke of how the churches might lead the way here by disinvesting from fossil fuel companies.
