Live Music, Food, Stalls and Children's Activities.

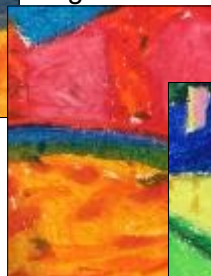
New Years Eve Celebrations Sunday 31st December 7pm
