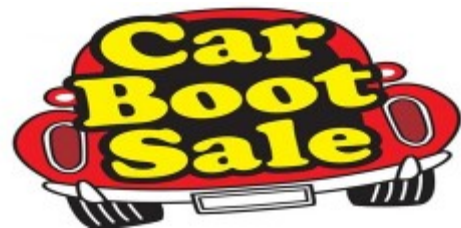
COMPLEXions – an exhibition of
