Activities on the Village Square have been up and running since November 2016, where we engage with young people outside of the traditional youth club sessions. The Village Square is a place where young people like to congregate after school has finished, and the idea of having provision there is to engage young people on their terms, and reach out to those that may not want to access the youth project in other ways.

Some of the key aims for the provision on the Village Square are: To provide a safe environment for young people, where they feel welcome, and free to express themselves without fear of harassment.



The current craze for colour therapy books was brought to Janice Rider's notice by a gift of the Penrose Tiling pattern book, created by mathematician Sir Roger Penrose.
