Mon June 3rd -Sun July 14th Linda says that as far back as she can remember watching at stations has been fascinating. People coming and going. Busy in their world. Where are they coming from? Where are they going to?

From busy international stations around the world to the quiet and sleepy Bournville Station.
Opened 3rd April 1876 as Stirchley Street it was a single track. Cadbury Bournville opened in 1879 and in 1880 the station became Stirchley Street and Bournville. In 1885 a southbound platform was built, squeezing in between the existing one and the Birmingham Worcester canal. In 1904 the station was renamed Bournville. It is quite a striking local station and well worth a look.
