Linda says that as far back as she
can remember watching at stations
has been fascinating. People coming
and going. Busy in their world.
Where are they coming from? Where
are they going to?

From busy international
stations around the world to the quiet
and sleepy Bournville Station.
Opened 3rd April 1876 as Stirchley
Street it was a single track. Cadbury
Bournville opened in 1879 and in
1880 the station became Stirchley
Street and Bournville. In 1885 a
southbound platform was built,
squeezing in between the existing
one and the Birmingham Worcester
canal. In 1904 the station was
renamed Bournville. It is quite a
striking local station and well worth a
look.

church on Sundays

The Robin Centre - 10 Years of Success !

The Robin Centre for older
people is 10 years old on July 13th
2019. Opened 10 years ago it has
been a tremendous success and
benefited hundreds of older people
with dementia by offering a quality day
service. This July 13th they are holding

friends of users of the centre.

Originally set up temporarily in
the Welcome Space of the All Saints
Centre (where the cafe is now) it
started with referrals from Birmingham
Social Services following the closure of
Chamberlain House day centre. It has
become a beacon of excellence for
older people suffering from dementia.

Present manager Paula McGrath
said "We have a dedicated trained
staff team, families love that we offer a
variety of stimulating activities and that

we can give them
respite from looking
after their loved ones
with dementia"
