The Robin Centre. like other day centres throughout the UK, was forced to close its doors to members when lockdown was introduced in March. It was a sudden and drastic step, but in all the circumstances inevitable.

Fortunately, the furlough scheme means we have kept most of our staff on the payroll, and we are determined to reopen as soon as this is allowed. Having regard to the health conditions of many of our members we know that this will require even more careful attention to hygiene than normal. 
