The Robin Centre Looks Forward



The Robin Centre has been closed, owing to Covid, since March. We have been keeping in phone contact with our members ever since to check on their wellbeing and have been sending activity packs, with puzzles, word searches, games etc., to those who want them. For a period, we were aiming to reopen in September, however, the Birmingham Tier 2 lockdown put a stop to that.

We have become more and more aware of the strain the lockdown is putting not only on members, but on less their families and carers. Looking after someone with dementia can be very challenging and although respite care may be available, not all carers are happy that their loved ones might be kept in isolation the whole time they are in respite care.

We are therefore exploring whether we can introduce a Companionship Service, in which one of our staff visits a member at home for a few hours thus enabling the carer to have a break for that time, and go out for recreation or shopping for example. With appropriate safeguards, such as PPE and Covid testing for staff, we are confident we can supply this service at a small charge. So we are now consulting members' families and carers to see if there is any interest.

We do not need to restrict this to current members. So if you know anyone who would benefit from this service, please ask them to contact Sally Pell on 07887 751874 and she can explain it in more detail.
