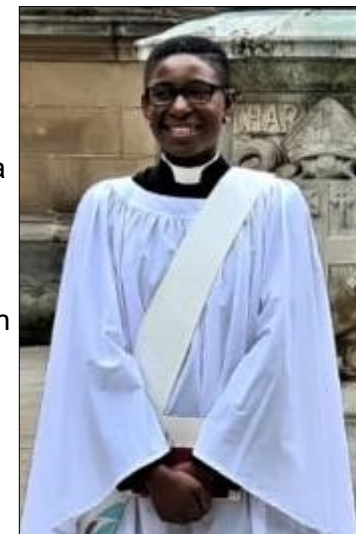
Introducing our new Assistant Curate
