**All Saints Youth Project's New Family Support Worker**



My name is Debbie Nixon and I am the new Family Support Worker supporting Ian Barber, Family Support Coordinator for All Saints Youth / Parent Project. I have been in post since May of this year. My role is to inform and support parents who have a young person with (and without) additional needs to access services and resources already in place through All Saints Youth Project. I feel immensely privileged to be part of a team that has young people, their families and community at the core of their work. I have observed that a safe and welcoming environment has been nurtured by the staff team which allows young people and parents to engage

with the staff and in turn promote better outcomes for young people and families. Since being in post, I've supported families with a number of issues ranging from housing support, sleeping difficulties, one to one parent sessions and safeguarding. I'm also excited to pass on that I've been asked to set up a stay and play to support teenage parents. The main focus of the group will be to provide a venue where young parents can meet other young parents, share similar issues, feel not judged and to pick up ideas to support them to continue their babies' learning at home. Local Health Visiting teams and Senior Social Work teams have been informed of the group. The group will start on Tuesday 28th September. I look forward to keeping you all updated on the groups progress.
