Born in 1947 in Birmingham Terry studied Technical Illustration and Graphic Design at the College of Art in Margaret Street. He worked for many years as a Commercial Artist successfully developing his own Design Consultancy. In 2003 Terry had a stroke which affected the left side of his body and forced him to take early retirement. At this point in his life Terry spent more time developing his own style of painting He was particularly fascinated by the sea and sky.
