Queen Elizabeth 2nd 1926 - 2022

On 8th Sept 2022 Queen Elizabeth II, the **UK's longest-serving** monarch, died peacefully at Balmoral aged 96, after reigning for 70 years.

All Saints opened for the day on Friday 9th and

Saturday 10th September for anyone wishing to reflect on the Queen's death might find some space and peace. Among the hundred and fifty or so people who called by, lighting candles and writing pages for a book of condolences, it was striking how many were young, some children after school, young parents with push chairs and shopping, people of different faiths and backgrounds. It was calm and touching.

Over the ten days of national mourning, prayers at All Saints reflected the paradox that it has taken a bereavement to unify the four nations that comprise Britain. After years of divisive, self-harming politics, the Monarch's death has had a curiously soothing effect on public life, just for a while. Whatever diverse opinions about monarchy there are across our fascinating neighbourhood, we have given thanks for this pause for thought about the bitter tone of so much of our political discourse. There is to be another All Saints Pantomime! (Oh yes there is...!)


We will be putting on Dick Whittington on Saturday 11 February 2023.
