The British Legion Club in Kings Heath closed down a few years ago. Outside was the memorial to those of Kings Heath who died in the Second World War. All Saints has the First World War Memorial inside the Church

They donated it to All Saints but we struggled to find a suitable place to site it. Prior to November 11th it was placed outside the All Saints Memorial Cross in the Village Square.

The Church was decorated with poppies (real and knitted) for a very moving service on Remembrance Sunday which also remembered those in Gaza, Israel and Ukraine.
