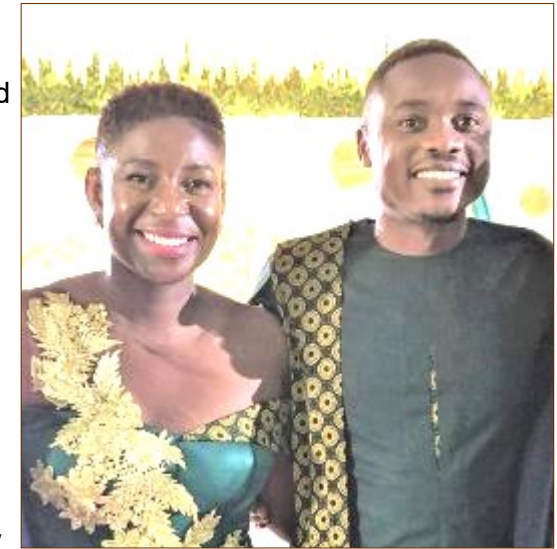


## Coming soon..... A Festival of All Saints Weddings: Past, Present and Future
